

Dear Mr. Swain,

I received a copy of the letter that you sent to Mr. Frank N. Fluckiger dated February 12, 2014 and which I received on February 18, 2014. I was shocked to read that you wrote that you had not received any response from me. I am resending to you a copy of my November 27, 2013 letter suggesting that Mr. Jacobs owes me a refund. Mr. Fluckiger received a copy of my November 27, 2013 letter and I cannot understand why you did not receive the letter.

First, I would point out that I was on the Alabama ballot as an independent and my petitions clearly stated that. To my knowledge, Mr. Fluckiger and the Constitution Party had no agreement with Mr. Jacobs to pay him for Alabama signatures. I paid Mr. Jacobs for 7,000 signatures that included a bonus. Over and above the payment for those signatures and that bonus, I paid him an additional \$1,000.00.

I have had the opportunity to review the petitions, and it is clear that Mr. Jacobs owes me a refund of at least \$340.00.

The total number of signatures that was provided to me by the Office of the Secretary of State, Elections Division, was 7,198. I am not including any for Gary Johnson or Jill Stein whose petitions Mr. Jacobs and his helpers were carrying when they got signatures for me. Enclosed is a copy of a Gary Johnson petition that was included with my petitions.

As I indicated in my November 27, 2013 letter, others besides Mr. Jacobs got signatures on my behalf. I personally saw about 50 signatures on petitions for me when I visited Alabama in the summer of 2013. Another 200 were gotten primarily in Northern Alabama on my behalf.

I have deducted illegible signatures and illegible other information that rendered the names and signatures unable to be determined. My agreement with Mr. Jacobs was for legible names that had a chance of being a registered voter. The total of the unable to be determined so far is 118. This number will likely increase as we continue our reviews.

I also expect in the near future to eliminate the names of any who signed my petitions more than once.


I would reiterate that Mr. Jacobs is not due any money for copies. He was to pay all costs including copy fees. In fact, during our several conversations about what the accurate number was, he never mentioned any copy fees.

Also, as I indicated in my November 27, 2013 letter, Mr. Jacobs promised in late 2012 to send me a letter setting forth the basis for his claimed numbers and his address and social security number so that a 1099 could be prepared for him. I was also surprised to see that Mr. Jacobs apparently is a resident of Pennsylvania because the checks for petitions were mailed to North Dakota and Cheyenne, Wyoming. Please have Mr. Jacobs comply with his late 2012 agreement with me.

$7,198 - 250 - 188 = 6,830$. Therefore, please have Mr. Jacobs send a refund of \$340.00. If he does this promptly, I will settle for that amount.

This is to acknowledge your letter dated November 18, 2013 and received on November 25, 2013.

Mr. Jacobs and I have talked about his signature collection in Alabama and disagree over his numbers and their validity. During the wrap-up of the campaign, I talked again with Mr. Jacobs and he agreed to send me a letter setting forth what he believes was the number of legible Alabama signatures that he and his helpers collected together with his home address and his social security number so that the campaign could prepare a 1099. I never received any written communication from him

It is quite possible that Mr. Jacobs owes a refund. I was in Alabama during the campaign and saw far more than 21 signatures that Mr. Jacobs alleges was all that he did not collect.

It is absurd to suggest that copying costs are due to Mr. Jacobs. All expenses were to be paid by him. Since he made so many copies, I would be grateful if you could send them to me so that I might review the signatures and addresses.

To my knowledge, the Constitution Party had no agreement to pay Mr. Jacobs anything in connection with Alabama.

I look forward to your sending the requested information.
